The Charité extends over four campuses, and has close to 100 different departments and institutes, which make up a total of 17 different CharitéCenters. Applications are invited for the following position at the Institute of Biochemistry in the Charité Center 02 for Basic Medicine to commence as soon as possible:

Professorship for Molecular Membrane Biology lifetime position

The teaching obligation is based on the Teaching Obligation Ordinance for Berlin Universities (LVVO).

The professorship is associated with a scientific focus on molecular membrane biology and its teaching.

We are looking for a nationally and internationally recognized scientist in one of the following or similar disciplines: molecular membrane biology, membrane transport, lipid biology, membrane physiology, physiological chemistry of the membrane or cell biology of the membrane. Preference is given to research programs that focus on basic systems approaches that are applicable to multiple physiological processes and are disease-agnostic in nature. The position is scientifically independent and suitable for applicants who conduct both experimental and data-driven research and work on basic or translational projects.

The future professor is expected to fulfill the following responsibilities and criteria:

1. Representation of the area "Molecular Membrane Biology" in research, teaching and academic self-administration in compliance with the standards of robust, reproducible, transparent and responsible science, including the consideration of gender and diversity.
2. Proof of successfully applied and completed scientific projects in the field of membrane biology.
3. A focus on molecular membrane biology, membrane transport, lipid biology, membrane physiology, physiological chemistry of the membrane or cell biology of the membrane in the scientific field is desirable.
4. Appropriate international reputation in the field of research, demonstrated by corresponding publications and successful acquisition of third-party funding and collaborative projects.
5. Experience in and commitment to teaching, excellent didactic skills and willingness to actively participate in the design of the medical education curriculum at the Charité as well as ensuring sound postgraduate education and training as well as commitment to the promotion of young physicians and scientists.
6. Integration into relevant research foci and collaborative research programs and interfaculty research networks / graduate colleges of the Charité as well as into the future-oriented strategic initiatives of the Charité (Charité 2030 and Charité Internationalization Strategy).
7. Cooperation with the preclinical and clinical facilities of the Charité and other institutions in Berlin and Brandenburg.

Applicants must demonstrate through their previous scientific work that they fulfill the above expectations of the W2 professorship, actively contribute to the scientific activities in the field of molecular membrane biology and complement the existing research activities in these areas at the Charité.

Formal requirements: According to § 100 BerlHG, successfully completed university studies and a completed doctorate in natural sciences or related subjects, professorship or junior professorship or habilitation and teaching authorization or scientific achievements equivalent to habilitation. It is desirable that international applicants can provide proof of a German language diploma / language certificate (according to the Conference of Ministers of Education and Cultural Affairs) at C1 level (specialized language skills).

The Charité pursues the sustainable consideration of gender and diversity in the personnel structures of science and care and thus seeks to increase in the proportion of women in scientific personnel and strongly encourages women to apply. Women with equivalent qualifications will be given priority within the scope of legal possibilities.

Severely disabled applicants with equal qualifications are given preference. We value diversity and therefore welcome all applications - regardless of gender, nationality, social background, religion or age.
